## Cash Rebates for Business Customers **REBATE APPLICATION**

### ELIGIBILITY

- Customers eligible for the 2009 Express Efficiency program are defined as non-delinquent core and non-core commercial, industrial, and agricultural accounts.
- The total rebate limit for the 2009 Express Efficiency program is \$200,000 per customer, per program year. Customers with corporate (multiple) accounts cannot exceed \$200,000 per corporation or chain account customer, per year.
- The total greenhouse heat curtain rebate cannot exceed the lesser of:
  - \$50,000 per account per year, or
  - 50% of the accounts preceding 12 month's natural gas consumption (therms) x \$0.80 (average prorated if less than 12 months usage is available).
- Boiler and large instantaneous water heater rebates cannot exceed \$25,000 per unit, subject to the maximum \$200,000 rebate limit per customer, per year. See Terms and Conditions for details.

### REQUIREMENTS

- Rebate items must be installed and operational at the Southern California Gas Company natural gas service account location listed on the rebate form.
- All purchase invoices or receipts must be dated between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2009. Applications received after this date will be subject to the terms and conditions applicable to the current program year. All rebate items must be purchased and installed prior to submitting a rebate form.
- Rebates cannot be combined with other public goods charge rebate(s) or incentive programs for the same measure.
- Equipment must meet the requirements as stated in the 2009 Express Efficiency Terms and Conditions. All equipment must be new. Used or rebuilt equipment is not eligible for rebate. Fuel switching and new construction do not qualify. If you have questions regarding the program, check with your local Southern California Gas Company representative to confirm eligibility and reserve funds before purchasing products. Southern California Gas Company reserves the right to deny payment for products that do not meet our requirements and to verify installation.

- Rebate payments are the property of the applicant (customer). The applicant may assign payment to a third party. Payment Release Authorization section on this application must be completed.
- The selection, purchase and ownership of the equipment is the sole responsibility of the customer. Southern California Gas Company makes no representation as to the safety, reliability and/or efficiency of the equipment selected or components thereof. Southern California Gas Company makes no warranty, whether expressed or implied, including warranty of merchantability or fitness for any particular purpose, use, or application of the equipment.

### HOW TO APPLY

1. To ensure funding availability, you must reserve funds before you purchase and install equipment. Call (800) 508-2348 to reserve your funds.
2. Using the Rebate Worksheet, calculate your rebate by multiplying the Quantity Purchased (Column A) times the Input Rating (Column B) times the Rebate/Unit (Column C) and write the amount in Column D. Your rebate for each product cannot exceed the price you paid for it, excluding tax and shipping cost.
3. Add all the rebate amounts in Column D and write the Base Rebate amount in the space provided at the bottom of the Rebate Worksheet.
4. **Include the model number and manufacturer of the equipment** on the paid, itemized invoice(s) or receipt(s). Circle the energy-saving product(s) for which a rebate is requested and label each one with its category letter.
5. Complete, sign and date the rebate form. **Note: Please send an application with an original signature in ink. Copies or faxed signatures will not be accepted.**

# 2009 Express Efficiency Terms and Conditions

**Technical Requirements:** Rebates are available only for the replacement of older, inefficient gas equipment and additional new equipment at existing accounts. If you are uncertain whether equipment qualifies, contact a Southern California Gas Company representative. California Energy Commission (CEC) and/or Gas Appliance Manufacturers Association (GAMA) equipment efficiency listed ratings prevail over all submitted technical documentation, unless otherwise approved. If the size and efficiency are not shown on the invoice, you must include a manufacturer's specification sheet documenting these characteristics. Properties such as homes, condominiums, apartments or any other residential dwellings do not qualify.

## A. RESIDENTIAL HIGH EFFICIENCY

### CLOTHES-WASHER USED IN A BUSINESS (Not for Commercial Coin Operated Usage)

Rebate is for a high efficiency residential washer used at a business for onsite/in-house laundry, e.g. beauty parlor, barbers shop, etc. (Commercial coin operated equipment does not qualify)

**Qualifying Level 1 (\$35 Rebate)** residential clothes washers must have a Modified Energy Factor (MEF)  $\geq 2.0$  and a Water Factor (WF)  $\leq 6.0$ . Not all ENERGY STAR qualified residential clothes washers qualify for this rebate. **Qualifying Level 1** residential clothes washers may be viewed at <http://www.cee1.org/resid/seha/rwsh/rwsh-prod.pdf>, Tier 2

**Qualifying Level 2 (\$75 Rebate)** residential clothes washers must have a Modified Energy Factor (MEF)  $\geq 2.2$  and a Water Factor (WF)  $\leq 4.5$  or less. Not all ENERGY STAR qualified clothes washers qualify for this rebate. **Qualifying Level 2** residential clothes washers may be viewed at <http://www.cee1.org/resid/seha/rwsh/rwsh-prod.pdf>, Tier 3

† Modified Energy Factor (MEF) measures energy consumption of the total laundry cycle (washing and drying). It indicates how many cubic feet of laundry can be washed and dried with one kWh of electricity; the higher the number, the greater the efficiency.

†† Water Factor (WF) represents the number of gallons of water needed for each cubic foot of laundry. The lower number indicates lower consumption and more efficient use of water.

## B. Storage Water Heater

Water heaters must meet efficiency requirements based on size, as shown in Table 1. If the size and efficiency are not shown on the invoice, you must include a manufacturer's specification sheet documenting these characteristics. Equipment used for pools and spas does not qualify.

## C. Space Heating Boiler\*

Boilers must meet efficiency requirements based on size and type, as shown in Table 2. Include a manufacturer's specification sheet documenting these characteristics. Boiler must be used for space heating for human comfort as defined by California Titles 20 & 24 standards. **Space Heating Boilers**  $\geq 2,000,000$  Btu/h are eligible for stipulated Express Efficiency Program rebates or the calculated incentives through the Business Energy Efficiency Program. Boiler and large instantaneous water heater rebate cannot exceed \$25,000 per unit, subject to the maximum \$200,000 rebate limit per customer, per year.

## D. Commercial Boiler\* (Non-Space Conditioning/Non-Process Related)

Available to commercial end-use customers. Only boilers  $\geq 75,000$  Btu/h qualify. Must meet a minimum thermal efficiency of 84%. Include a manufacturer's specification sheet documenting these characteristics. Boiler must not be used for space conditioning for human comfort. Boiler must not be used for industrial (process) end-use. Equipment used for pools and spas does not qualify. **Commercial Boilers**  $\geq 2,000,000$  Btu/h are eligible for stipulated Express Efficiency Program rebates or the calculated incentives through the Business Energy Efficiency Program. Boiler and large instantaneous water heater rebate cannot exceed \$25,000 per unit, subject to the maximum \$200,000 rebate limit per customer, per year.

## E. Tankless Water Heater\*

Water heaters must meet efficiency requirements based on size, as shown in Table 3. The manufacturer name and equipment model number must be provided. Customers must provide proof of the tankless nature of the water heater (e.g., manufacturer equipment specification sheets). **Large Tankless Water Heaters**  $\geq 2,000,000$  Btu/h are eligible for stipulated Express Efficiency Program rebates or the calculated incentives through the Business Energy Efficiency Program. Boiler and large tankless water heater rebate cannot exceed \$25,000 per unit, subject to the maximum \$200,000 rebate limit per customer, per year.

## F. Process Boiler\*

Available to industrial end-use customers who manufacture a saleable product only (NAICS codes 31-33). Manufacturing involves the mechanical or chemical transformation of materials or substances into a new product which is neither a structure nor any other fixed improvement. Boilers must meet a minimum combustion efficiency of 82% as installed. Only process boilers (i.e., units not primarily used for domestic hot water, space conditioning, pool or spa use) qualify. The manufacturer name and equipment model number must be provided. A flue gas analysis measured under full load conditions is required to document combustion efficiency after installation is complete. **Process Boilers**  $\geq 2,000,000$  Btu/h are eligible for stipulated Express Efficiency Program rebates or the calculated incentives through the Business Energy Efficiency Program. Boiler and large instantaneous water heater rebate cannot exceed \$25,000 per unit, subject to the maximum \$200,000 rebate limit per customer, per year.

## G. Commercial Pool Heater

Available for swimming pool heating and must replace pre-existing pool heater. The commercial pool and spa heater must be certified to meet the following requirements: **1)** heater must be equal to or greater than 84% thermal efficiency, **2)** must have an "on/off" switch and have no pilot light.

## H. Direct Contact Water Heater

Only direct contact water heaters for process end-uses qualify (NAICS codes 31-33). In direct contact water heater systems design, heat from a flame comes into direct contact with small droplets of cold water which run through a stainless steel heat exchange media. Droplets composed from the process come into direct contact with rising heat from the flame and the water is heated directly. Direct Contact Water Heaters must meet efficiency requirements based on size as shown in Table 4.

All required efficiencies exceed Title 20 & 24 standards, as prescribed above.

## I. Pipe Insulation

**A minimum of 1 inch of pipe insulation** must be added to existing bare commercial or industrial steel pipe system applications. **The bare pipe size must be at least 1/2 inch or larger.** The following types of applications are not eligible: new construction; new pipe system replacement; fuel switching; residential. The fluid type (hot water, low-pressure steam ( $\leq 15$  psig), or medium-pressure steam ( $> 15$  psig)), the length of insulation installed at each pipe size, annual operating hours, the manufacturer's name, the insulation material type, and the material k-value rating must be provided. Customer's must also provide proof of insulating values (e.g., manufacturer's specification sheets).

 · Pipe diameter  $\geq 1"$  Steam  $\geq 15$ psi \$3.00/linear ft\*

## J. Tank Insulation

1" or 2" of fiber glass or foam insulation must be added to existing bare liquid or solution storage or transfer tanks that are coupled to gas-fired commercial or industrial equipment that transfers heat to the liquid or solution. The insulation thickness and tank solution temperature will determine the rebate amount. Additional required information will be the manufacturer's name, insulation material type, and the material k-value rating.

### 1" Tank Insulation Rebates

· \$3 sq/ft - 1" Tank insulation, high temperature application: 170 - 200 degrees F solution  
 · \$2 sq/ft - 1" Tank insulation, low temperature application: 120 - 170 degrees F solution

### 2" Tank Insulation Rebates

· \$4 sq/ft - 2" Tank insulation, high temperature application: 170 - 200 degrees F solution  
 · \$3 sq/ft - 2" Tank insulation, low temperature application: 120 - 170 degrees F solution

## K. Greenhouse Heat Curtain

Only installations of interior curtains for heat retention in existing gas-heated greenhouses qualify. The rebate applies to new and retrofit curtain system installations in existing greenhouses for specific agricultural end-use. Product must be designed by the manufacturer to be a heat curtain, and the installation must have the ability to automatically or manually move the curtain into place. Curtain must be located such that the gas heat source provides hot air to conditioned space bounded by the curtain. Curtain material must have an Energy Savings rating of  $\geq 40\%$ , and must have a warranty/product life of 5 years. Include a manufacturer's specification sheet documenting type of curtain. Rebate amount cannot exceed square feet of qualifying curtain material purchased, paid for and properly installed at Southern California Gas Company account listed on the rebate form. Rebate amount also cannot exceed the square feet of floor space covered by the installation of the curtain material. Overhang and overlap of curtain material does not qualify for rebates. The total greenhouse heat curtain rebate cannot exceed the lesser of:

· \$50,000 per account per year, or  
 · 50% of the accounts preceding 12 month natural gas consumption (therms) x \$0.80 (average prorated if less than 12 months usage is available).

## L. Infrared Film for Greenhouses

Installations of single sheet infrared anti-condensate polyethylene plastic with a minimum 6 mil. thickness for heat retention on existing heated greenhouses will qualify. A manufacturer's specification sheet must be included.

## M. Steam Traps

The steam trap rebate is available to all commercial and industrial customers. Steam trap rebate levels are set based on three general categories:

- Industrial end use customers who manufacture a saleable product (NAICS codes 31-33) steam pressure  $> 15$  psig \$200.00/Unit
- Industrial end use customers who manufacture a saleable product (NAICS codes 31-33) steam pressure  $\leq 15$  psig or a Commercial Facility that operates 12 - 24 hrs/day – \$100.00/Unit
- Commercial facility that operate less than 12 hrs/day

All steam traps in an existing steam system that have been in service for a minimum of five years are eligible. New construction is not eligible. For each steam trap replaced, please provide steam trap manufacturer, model number, specification sheet, paid purchase receipt with tax and shipping, construction style (mechanical, thermostatic, or thermodynamic), and steam trap size. Customer may be asked to verify the location of the replaced steam trap(s) in steam loop.

Small water	$< 300$ MBtu/h	AFUE $\geq 82\%$

All required efficiencies exceed Title 20 & 24 standards, as prescribed above.

**Table 3. Tankless Water Heater\***

Size	Input Rating	Required Efficiency
Small	$\leq 200$ MBtu/h	Energy Factor $\geq 0.63$
Large	$> 200$ MBtu/h	Thermal Efficiency $\geq 82\%$

All required efficiencies exceed Title 20 & 24 standards, as prescribed above.

\* **Commercial Boilers, Process Boilers, Space Heating Boilers and Large Instantaneous Water Heaters  $\geq 2,000,000$  Btu/h may be eligible for incentives through the Local Business Energy Efficiency Program only if Southern California Gas Company is contacted prior to the purchase of the equipment, and a BEEP Agreement is executed prior to the purchase of such equipment. If the equipment is purchased prior to having a BEEP Agreement in place, and all other Express Efficiency Program requirements are met, then the equipment would be eligible for the Express Efficiency Program rebate only and subject to applicable measure caps. ## Definitions

**Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE):** the ratio of annual output energy to annual input energy.

**Combustion Efficiency (CE):** 100 times (1 - energy lost to flue) divided by input energy.

**Thermal Efficiency (TE):** 100 times useful energy output divided by input energy.
