

2009 Commercial Foodservice Equipment REBATE APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY

- Customers eligible for the 2009 Commercial Foodservice Equipment Rebate program are defined as non-delinquent core and non-core commercial, industrial, or agricultural accounts.
- The total rebate limit for the Commercial Foodservice Equipment Rebate program is **\$25,000** per account, per year.

REQUIREMENTS

- Rebate items must be installed and operational at the Southern California Gas Company natural gas service account location listed on the rebate application.
- All purchase invoices or receipts must be dated between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2009. All rebate items must be purchased and installed prior to submitting an application for a rebate.
- Rebates cannot be combined with other public goods charge rebate(s) or incentive programs for the same measure(s).
- Equipment must meet the requirements as stated in the Terms and Conditions. Southern California Gas Company reserves the right to verify installation and deny payment for products that do not meet our requirements.
- Qualified equipment must be installed at the facility served by the Southern California Gas Company account listed on the application and must be installed and operational according to local building codes and ordinances and/or manufacturer's requirements.

HOW TO APPLY

1. To ensure funding availability, you must reserve funds before you purchase and install equipment. Call (800) 508-2348 to reserve your funds.
2. Calculate your rebate on page 3 of this application. Multiply the Quantity Purchased (Column A) by the Rebate/Unit (Column B). Write this amount in Column C. Your rebate for each product cannot exceed the equipment cost, excluding tax, labor and shipping cost. Invoice(s) must be itemized (equipment cost, freight, tax and labor).
3. Add all the rebate amounts in Column C and write the Total Base Rebate Amount in the space provided at the bottom of the application.
4. On the paid itemized invoice(s) or receipt(s), circle the energy-saving product(s) for which a rebate is requested and label each one with its category letter. Be sure that the manufacturer name, equipment type, model number, serial number, unit price and unit quantity of each item appears on the invoice.
5. Fill out the Customer Information section on page 4. Sign and date at the bottom. **Note: Please send an application with an original signature in ink. Copies or faxed signatures will not be accepted.**
6. Attach the copy of the itemized invoice(s), and other pertinent documents to your original application and mail to:

2009 Commercial Foodservice Equipment Terms and Conditions

Technical Requirements: Rebates are available for the purchase of new replacement energy efficient gas equipment at existing facilities and additional new equipment at existing accounts. Customers who are uncertain whether equipment qualifies should contact a representative of Southern California Gas Company to confirm eligibility before purchasing products.

Equipment Eligibility

All equipment must be new. Used or rebuilt equipment is not eligible for rebates. Fuel switching does not apply. New construction may apply if it is outside the scope of Southern California Gas Company's Savings by Design program. Properties such as homes, condominiums, apartments or any other residential dwellings do not qualify. No rebates will be paid on new equipment that replaces equipment for which the customer has received a rebate from Southern California Gas Company within the last five (5) years.

Rebate Payment

Upon timely receipt of approved Customer invoice(s) for qualifying equipment (which shall include itemized materials, freight, labor and tax costs plus documentation specifying manufacturer, make, model number and serial number of purchased equipment), Southern California Gas Company shall pay Customer, the qualified rebate resulting from this application. The precise amount is subject to subsequent adjustments by Southern California Gas Company.

Equipment Verification

Southern California Gas Company shall have access to the equipment during Customer's normal business hours to verify installation and equipment specifications and to test and verify the efficiency of the

equipment. All data will be confidential and accessible to the customer upon written request.

Evaluation Study

If selected, the Customer agrees to participate in a program measurement and evaluation study. This type of study is used to analyze current program performance and improve future programs.

Tax Liability

Customer must comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, regulations, and tax laws. The California State Board of Equalization requires retailers to charge sales tax on the purchase price of products before a rebate is taken. Southern California Gas Company does not rebate sales tax.

1. I do not provide Southern California Gas Company with 100% of the related energy benefits specified in the rebate form for the life of the product or for a period of five (5) years from receipt of rebate, whichever is less, or
2. I cease to be a customer of Southern California Gas Company during said time period,
I shall refund a prorated amount of rebate dollars to Southern California Gas Company based on the actual period of time for which I provided the related energy benefits as a natural gas customer of Southern California Gas Company.

I understand that this program may be modified or terminated without prior notice. I understand that this rebate form and the paid itemized invoice must be received at Southern California Gas Company's Central Processing Center or postmarked no later than December 31, 2009 and that all equipment must be purchased and installed prior to submission of the rebate form.

In the event that I choose to participate in the On-Bill Financing Program offered by Southern California Gas Company to obtain financing for the products listed on this rebate form, I understand that the term and conditions of participation in the On-Bill Financing Program will control (including, without limitation, the calculation of the rebate amount for the products listed in this rebate form) if there is any conflict between the terms and conditions applicable to participation in this program and the On-Bill Financing Program.

In no case will the utility pay more than 100% of the actual purchase price of the items to be rebated. This program has a limited budget. If no reservation has been made, rebate forms will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, until allocated funds are no longer available, or by December 31, 2009, whichever comes first.

I agree that I have not received rebates, incentives or services for the same measure(s) from other utilities, state, or local programs funded by the Public Goods Charge (PGC).
