HOW DO I GET PLANTS?

1. Register and attend a California Friendly Landscaping workshop sponsored by West Basin Municipal Water District. For upcoming classes visit westbasin.org
2. Take a picture of your garden/yard.
3. Prepare your garden utilizing the knowledge gained at the workshop.
4. Contact The SEA Lab and schedule a time to pick-up your plants. Make sure you have the date of the workshop you attended.
5. Install your California native plants in your garden. (within 30 days)
6. Take a picture of your new garden and upload before and after pictures to westbasin.org
7. Enjoy your habitat garden!
